 +3 hours of the above or approved provider "onboarding"

New Mexico Administrative Code § 6.80.5.9 allows continuing members on certain charter school governing bodies to be exempted from up to four (4) hours of required training, if the school is meeting certain performance targets:

- A school's governing body members are *exempted* from the requirement to complete *two (2) hours of training relating to understanding and evaluating academic data* if:
 - The school has maintained a **letter grade of B or better** for the **three most recent years**, and
 - The school has received no rating below C in any area of the report card for the **current year**
- A school's governing body members are *exempted* from *two (2) of the three (3) hours of training relating to charter school fiscal requirements pursuant to the Public School Finance Act, NMSA 1978 § 22-8-1 et seq.* if
 - The school has received an **unmodified annual audit** in **each of the past three years** with **no material weaknesses, no multi-year repeat findings, no significant deficiencies**, and
 - The school has received no more than two compliance findings in the **current year**.
 - Please note board members must still complete one (1) hour of training in this area.
